It's easy to say what we would do if we were in a situation, when we're not. The disciples said they would not leave Jesus, but they all left him when the time came. (v.50)

Jesus Predicts Peter's Denial

A Young Man Flees Naked (v.51-52)

Jesus Faces the Sanhedrin (vs. 53-65)

Peter followed Jesus from a distance.

We cannot follow Jesus from a distance.

(John 2:18-20)

The witnesses in Mark told something told something that Jesus did not say. (v.58)

Jesus did not have a need to get the record straight. They said all kinds of things about Jesus and He said nothing.

We don't have to answer every accusation.

We need to hold our peace.

Jesus answers what needs to be answered. He will say Who He is.

We should have policies too. just like Social Media.

Disciples ran away.

Some lied on Him.

They spit on Him, beat Him, blindfolded Him and mocked Him.
