Mark 16:1-20

He Is Risen (v.1-8)

The women came to the tom and wondered who would roll away the stone, but it did not stop them.

Faith keeps going.

How many times do we allow obstacles to stop us?

We need to keep fighting. And not let go until God blesses us.

There's a blessing in the going.

In consistency lies the power.

God orders steps. We have to do some stepping before God does some ordering.

Jesus not only died, He got up.

We can get up because Jesus got up.

Jesus made mention specifically of Peter to let him know that their relationship was good.

Mary Magdalene Sees the Risen Lord (v.9-11)

The story of Mark continues, perhaps because God did not want it to end on being afraid. If the text was added (v.9-20), the Lord wanted it there.

Jesus Appears to Two Disciples (v.12-13)

The Great Commission (v.14-18)

Jesus was not happy because they did not believe neither Mary Magdalene or the two disciples on the road to Emmaus.

The angel said it, Jesus said it, Mary said it, and the two said it, yet the disciples believed not.

We need to believe. It is our belief that will save us.
